Please note:

NMI students must complete a minimum of 2 planned hospital births during their time as a midwifery student. These hospital births can be in any role (Observe, Assist, Primary). Transfers to hospital from a planned home birth do NOT count as a planned hospital birth, but following a client's birth after a prenatal transfer to obstetrical care and subsequent plan for hospital birth CAN count. Hospital births can be paid births (i.e. doula births).

All required minimum clinical experience must occur within the last 10 years from NARM application date and graduation.

Students are required to use client codes (not names) on all experience documentation. Clinical experience documentation with client names will be returned to the student for resubmission.
